Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) is a national communications system implemented in all provinces and territories of Canada.

WHMIS requires that suppliers, employers, and workers use the system to identify and handle hazardous materials safely.

The training Session will provide a general understanding of the safe and efficient handling of Hazardous materials in the workplace

This training session is followed by a short exam to insure that all participants understand the main components of WHMIS and what is required of them and the employer under Alberta's WHMIS regulations.
